***MY FATHER IS WORKING***

**John 5:1-9**

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- **The myth was that the waters stirred because of an angel who would heal the first one in the water.**
- **Among the needy was a man crippled for 38 years.**

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- **This was a sign that caused wonder, but not for all.**

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- **The man told the Jews who healed him, setting up a confrontation between them and Jesus.**



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  - **Consider Exodus 31:13-17. Did Jesus violate the law expressed in this passage?**
  - **Consider Jeremiah 17:21-22. Did Jesus violate the law expressed in this passage?**

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  - While Jesus did not violate God's law, he did violate the *Mishnah Shabbat*.
  - While it's commendable that the elders of Israel wanted to honor God, their rules replaced his Word.

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  - **Any work that God works is a permissible work.**
  - **Jesus made a serious claim about his relationship to God when he used the words “*my* Father.”**

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- **We are not free to work any work we want to work in the name of God.**
- **Yet, any work God works is permissible work.**
- **Be free to love God and neighbor, and trust that God will lead in the way you should go.**
