# **The Judgment of the Son (5:24-30)**

- **To have life, we must hear the words of the Son and believe the Father who sent him.**
- **Since the Father has vested authority in the Son, he has the power to give life and to judge.**
- **As Jesus judges here and now, so he will judge on the final day.**
