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- Rather than comforting them, Jesus stretched their faith even further.**
- It's said that his own disciples did not believe, but Jesus did not despair.**

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- God the Father is ultimately responsible for the gift of eternal life.**

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- **While this was sad, Jesus was interested in discipleship and not numbers.**
- **Jesus asked his own disciples if they wanted to leave him as well, expecting them to say, "No."**
- **Peter spoke for the twelve and affirmed their commitment to Jesus.**

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- **While more than twelve disciples remained faithful to him, what was more important is that he remained faithful to his Father.**

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- 4. God's sovereignty kills discouragement and breeds contentment when we share the gospel at home or abroad and don't see a lot of fruit.**

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- 10. God's sovereignty means that our lives will be an eternal glory to Christ (Ephesians 2:7).**

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
