John 7:37-39

The Promise of the Spirit (7:37-39)

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 - **The people would travel to Jerusalem and construct tents of leafy branches.**
 - **The population of the city would swell and the landscape would be transformed.**
 - **It was their “Season of Rejoicing”!**

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 - **In the morning, the high priest would lead the priests and people to the Pool of Siloam to draw water.**
 - **He would then lead them to the temple: the people stayed outside, and the priests processed once around the altar.**
 - **As they processed, the temple choir would sing the *Hallel*, that is, Psalms 113-116.**

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- On the seventh day, the priests would process around the altar three times and on the eighth day, a day of rest, they would not enact this ritual.**

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- **This probably refers to Psalm 78:15-16, or perhaps Isaiah 58:11.**

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- **Even today, when people encounter Jesus they react with passion in one way or another.**

The Sanhedrin and the Officers (7:45-52)

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- The Sanhedrin felt the crowd was foolish and therefore they pronounced on them a curse.**
- Nicodemus raised a procedural point but his colleagues had no desire to hear it.**

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- **Nicodemus offered no rebuttal and it seems the conversation ended in a stalemate.**
- **The stage was set for the death of Jesus, but in his death would be the sacrifice for the sins of all who believe, including those who plotted against him.**

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- **Though we may not feel satisfied, he satisfies our needs; though we may not feel rivers of water flowing from us, he uses us by grace to bless the lives of others.**
